# Librarian's Report:

The Library Director presented his reports on staff, building and grounds, programming, finances, technology, and the Friends of the Berkley Public Library fundraising. Highlights of the report include:

- Heather Earnely, Library Clerk, worked her last shift on 1/29.
- The City hosted a COVID vaccine clinic for City staff on 3/19. All library staff are vaccinated
- A total of 34 people attending virtual story times between February and March.
- A total of 605 kids and 52 teens took home take home crafts February through March.
- 12 people participated in the *Tinderbox* author talk in February.
- Pronunciator was added as an online language learning resource.
- A sprinkler system inspection and maintenance work was completed.
- A paper recycling dumpster is now available in the library parking lot for library and public use.
- Friends donated two bags of books and movies for the Berkley Education Foundation fundraiser.

# **Old Business:**

<u>Circulation</u>: Overall circulation is staying pretty steady with pick-up only continuing. COVID response:

- Maintain phase one.
- Book quarantine will decrease as number of positive cases decreases in the county.
- Building is being sprayed every night with organic sanitizer.
- HVAC systems was updated to increase the fresh air intake.
